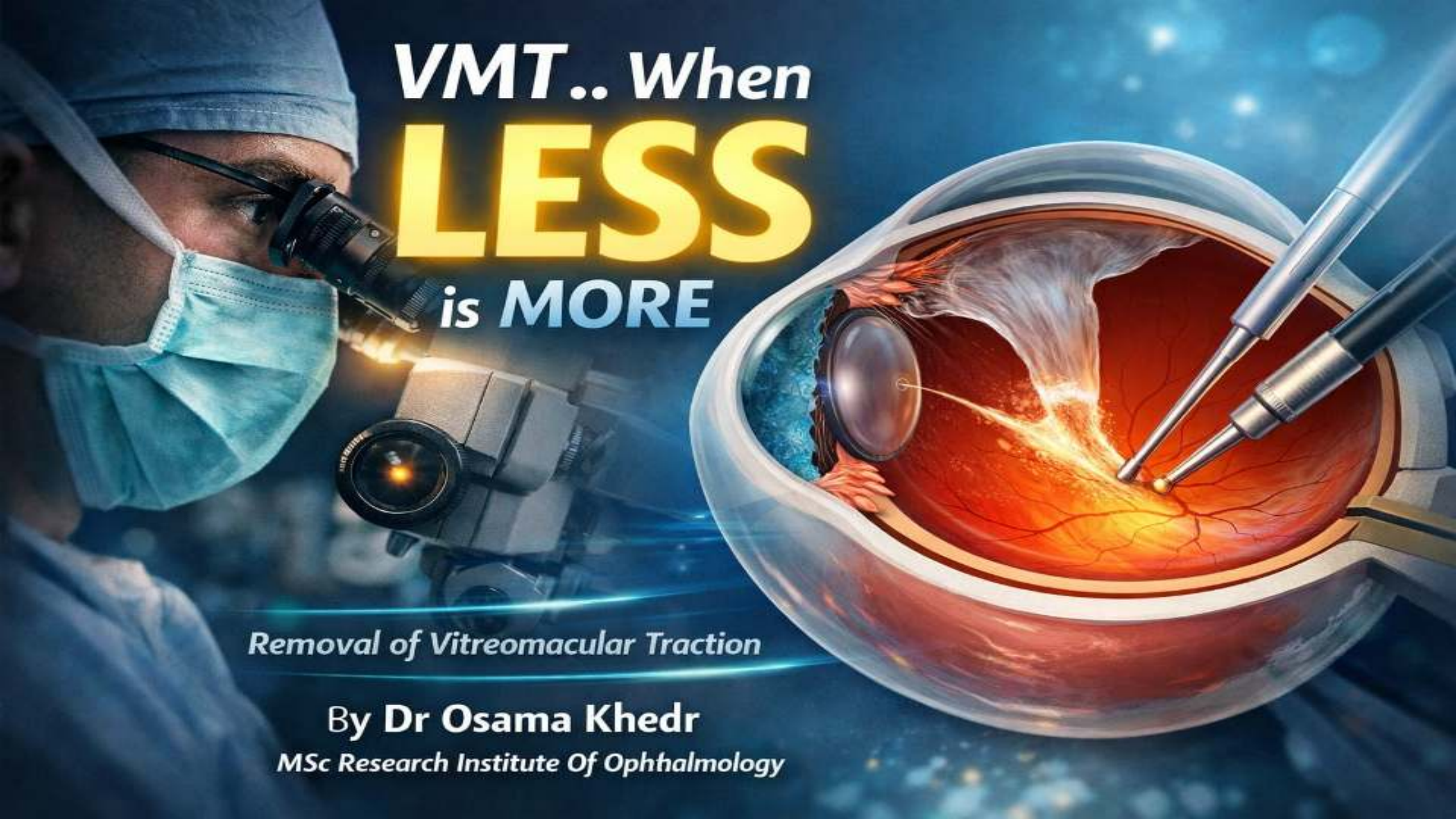




VMT.. When **LESS** is MORE

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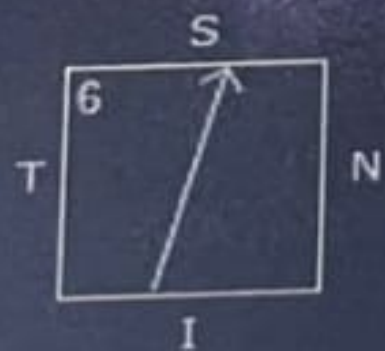
Case presentation

A 65 –year-old ,male Presented with a h/x of **metamorphopsia** in the right eye which started few months ago and has been gradually progressive .

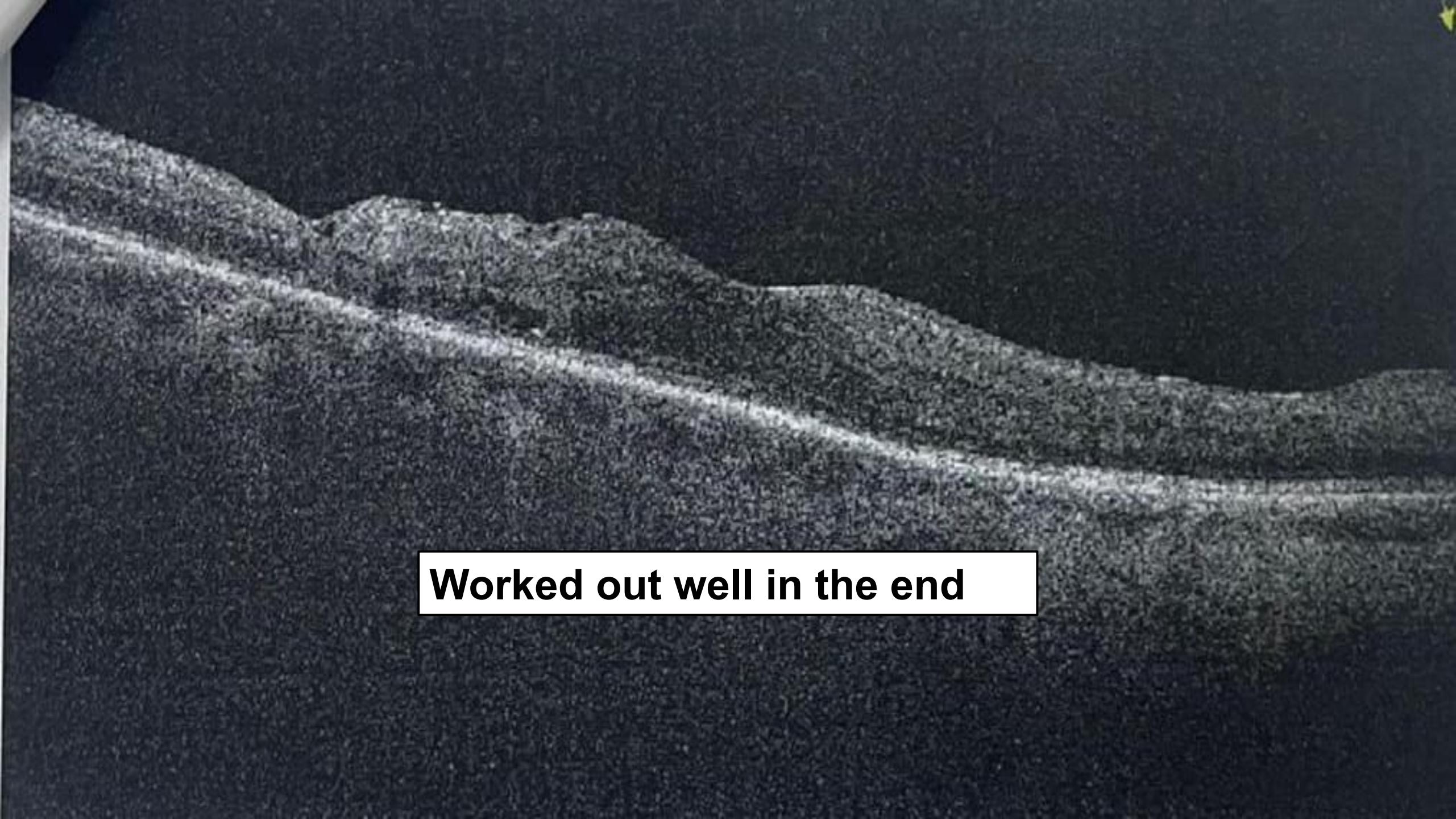
He is a known case of myopia.

There is no any h/o systemic illness .

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- ▶ OCT macula OD revealed VMT with a diameter of approximately >1500 micron .
 - ▶ Based on the significant traction and the patient's symptoms ,a decision was made to proceed with **PPV** and **ILM peeling**
