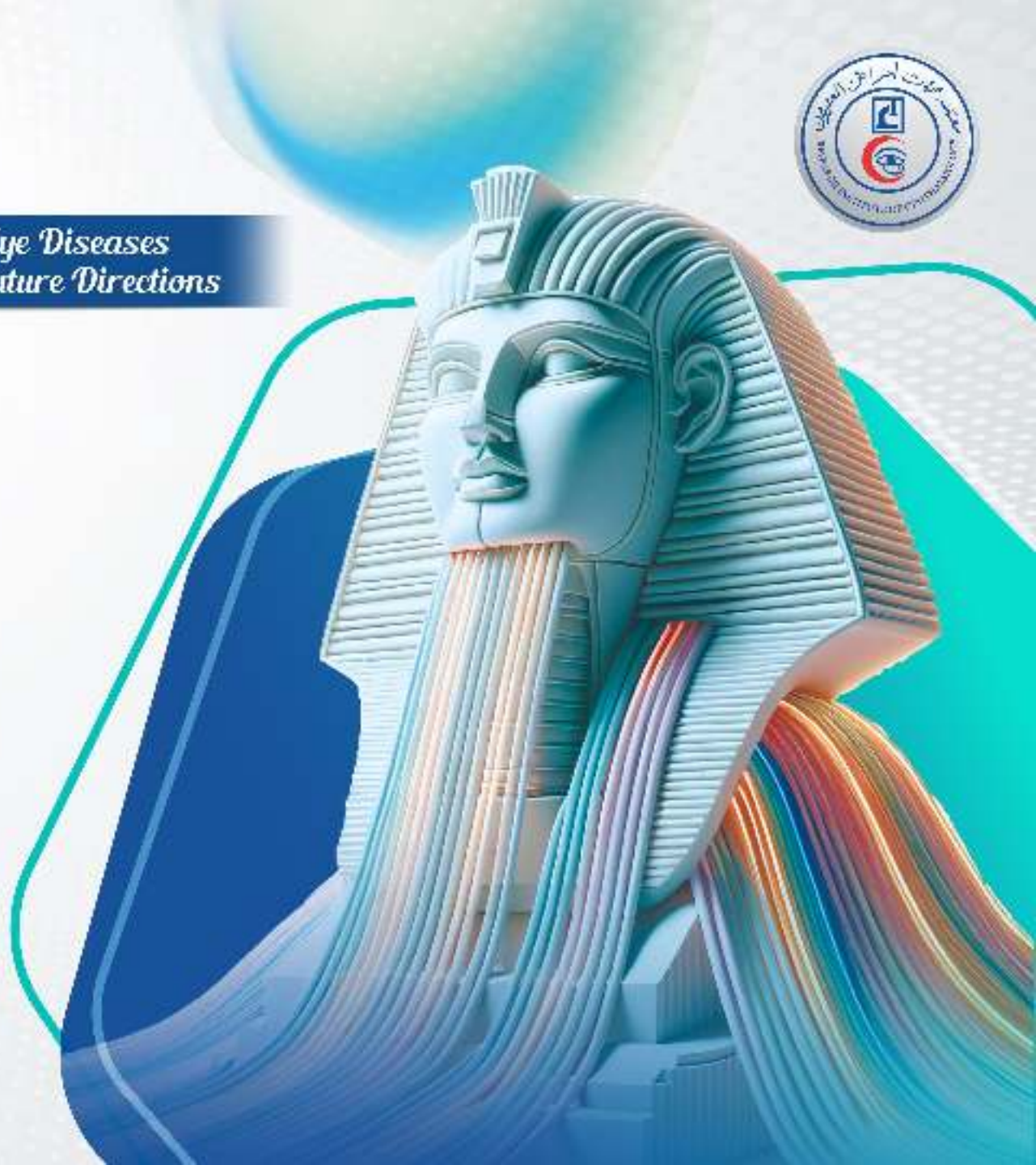

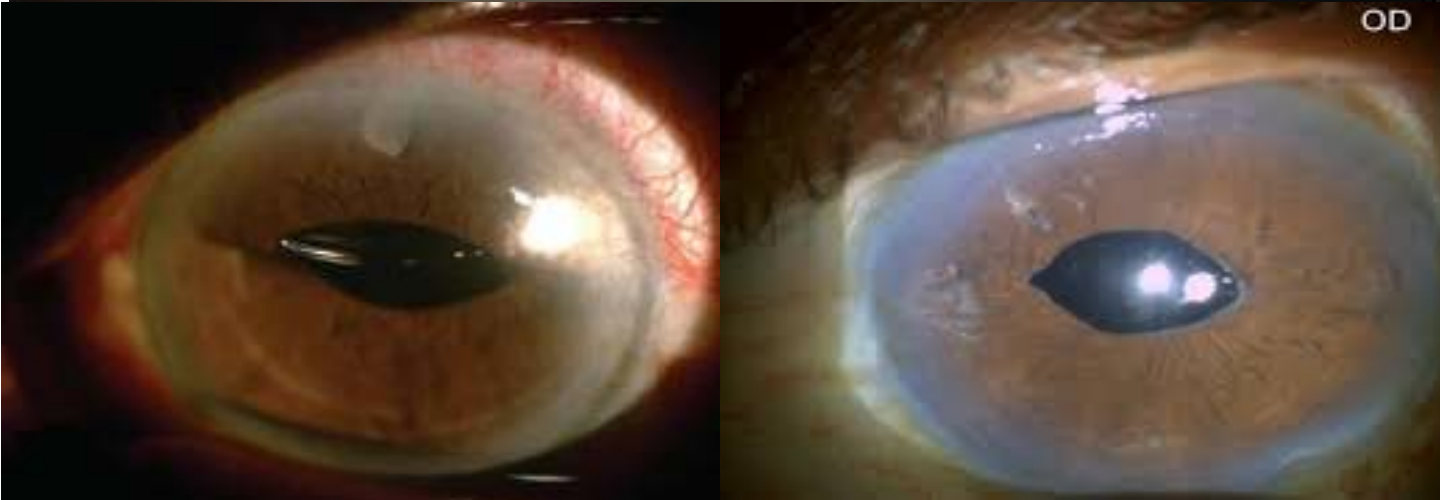
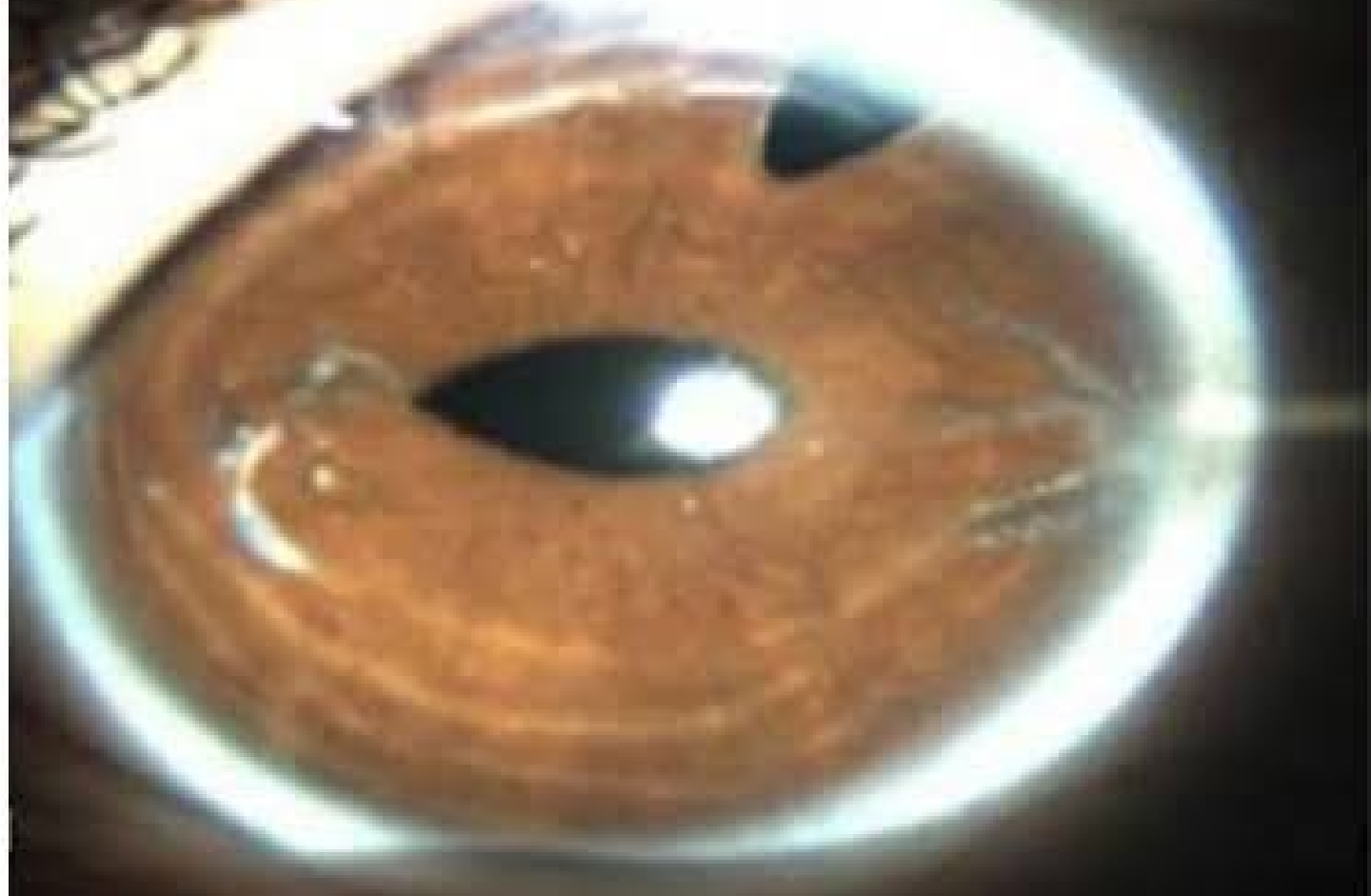
New technique for Iris Claw fixation

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- **“I have no financial interests .”**

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- Two potential problems with the standard procedure are that the pupil is not moved, and the iris is not stretched, and the enclavation is at a precise 180-degree angle, which needs expert hands.



TOOLS

- Globe Pressure maintainer
- Iris Claw
- 10-0 prolene straight needle (which is used as a guide and tool for enclavation sites perfectly 180 apart)
